The Auckland Curling Club wants to put together a Wheelchair Curling Team.

We have secured funding to run a series of five introductory classes with a World Curling Federation qualified Wheelchair Curling coach.

Timing for these classes will be on Monday mornings at Avondale Paradice for one hour from 9 am in Term 3. We know this is during school time, but due to the extreme competition for ice time, this is the only slot we are able to secure.

Once the basic skills have been learned, this group will then play in the Auckland School competition in 2024 (Thursday evenings in Terms 2 and 3) and we will then try and qualify the team for the World Wheelchair Curling championships. Long term we are looking at Olympic qualification.

We need at least five wheelchair athletes with a disability affecting their lower limbs or gait (and at least two of each gender).
